



ADVANCED HOME DEFENSE CARBINE COURSE

Prerequisites:

Students must be able to disassemble and reassemble their rifle, and have a very good understanding of weapon safety and carbine fundamentals. Students must complete ARMADA's carbine training series which consist of *Introduction to Carbine*, *Basic Home Defense Carbine* and *Intermediate Home Defense Carbine* courses (or equivalent) prior to attending the advanced level carbine course.

Course Summary:

This course is for advanced level shooters that want to improve their personal and home defense skills related to the carbine rifle. The curriculum is geared scenarios related to personal and home defense tactics. The objective of the course is to teach students to shoot faster, more accurately while in adverse environments and positions.

Carbine rifle, 3 magazines, magazine holder, cleaning kit, flashlight, (weapon mounted or hand held), ear and eye protection. Weapon lasers are encouraged and optional. Students are encouraged to wear clothing appropriate for climate and conditions, as well as bring water bottle or other hydration system.
