



## ADVANCED HOME DEFENSE SHOTGUN COURSE

### Prerequisites:

Students must have a good understanding of weapon safety fundamentals. Students must complete ARMADA's *Basic Home Defense Shotgun* course (or equivalent) prior to attending the advanced level pistol course.
